

5 Best Cricut Cutting Mats to Maximize Precision

It doesn't matter which Cricut machine you are using, but the [Cricut cutting mats](#) are the same for all of them. Before anything else, you need to understand what they are and what their importance is. Right now, there are 5 types of **cutting mats for Cricut** on the market that one can use while creating a new one. Simply put, they are easy-to-fold and reusable Cricut supplies that help crafters design their projects.

Besides, it comes with a strong adhesive applied over the mat that keeps the material firmly in place. Also, the mat will be available in different sizes and colors to help you finish the craft quickly. If you can't decide which model to choose, you have come to the correct place. Here, you will find full-fledged info about each mat.

1. Light Grip Mat, 12" x 12" (2 ct)

Beginning with the **Light Grip** mat it is best for materials such as standard paper, vellum, light cardstock, and more. Also, they are specially made for handling lightweight materials and are completely reusable. Among [Cricut cutting mats](#), the Light Grip mat holds the material tightly without any bubbles. Plus, removing the unwanted pieces from the mat is effortless after the cutting process ends. In addition, the LightGrip mat is available in blue color and comes in budget.



2. Fabric Grip Mat, 12" x 12" (4 ct)

Simultaneously, the DIYer uses this craft supply while making any project out of cotton, felt, polyester, denim, and canvas. As Cricut starts, it grabs the material so

it doesn't slip and damage the project. On the other hand, the Fabric Grip mat has a Rotary blade that quickly finishes the process. Also, this **Cricut cut mat** is pocket-friendly and comes in pink color. The pack comes with four **cutting mats for Cricut**, so you can prepare the other one while the first is loaded in the craft plotter.



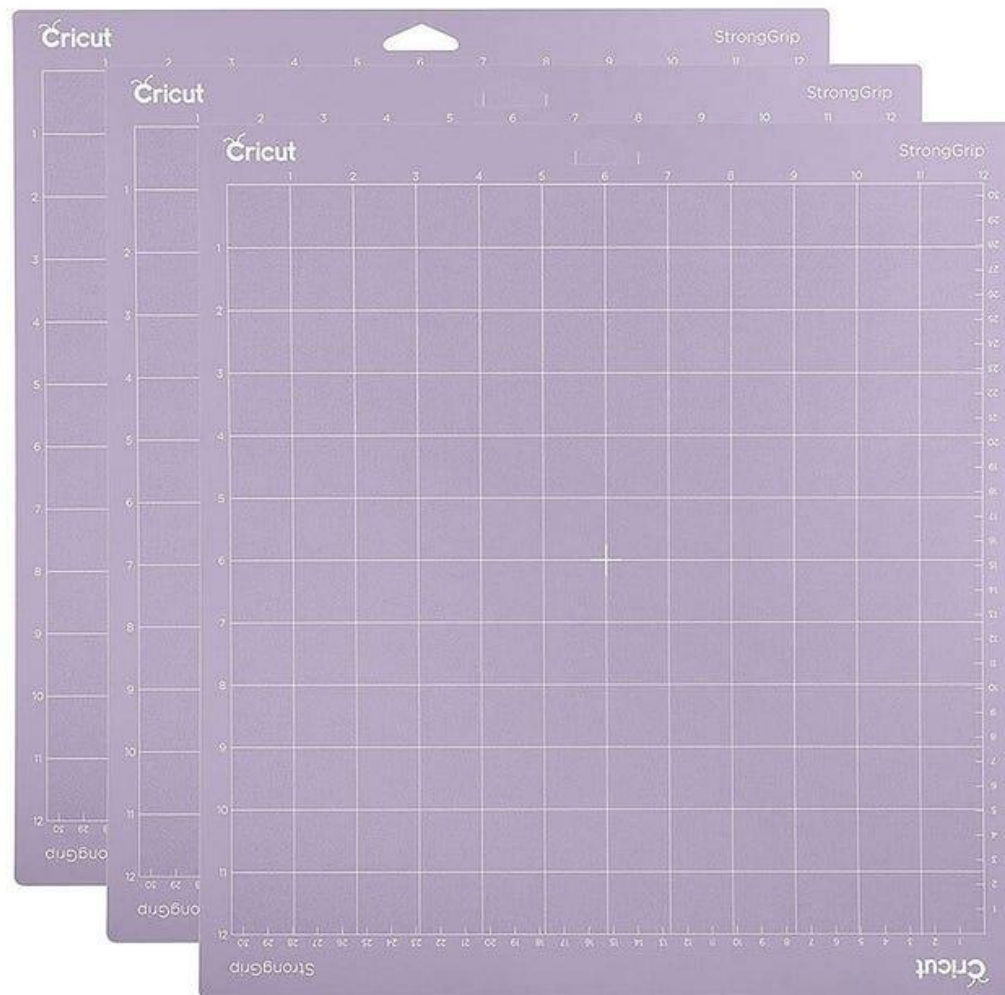
3. Standard Grip Mat, 12" x 12" (2 ct)

If you make a craft on heavy cardstock, vinyl, iron-on, patterned paper, and more, then the Standard Grip mat should be your first preference in the [Cricut cutting mats](#) list. Its strong adhesive keeps the loaded materials in place while the machine cuts them. Also, this craft tool comes in green color and is affordable. Once the cutting process is complete, you can easily peel off the extra material with the tweezers. Plus, they are compatible with Cricut Explore & Maker machines.



4. Strong Grip Mat, 12" x 12" (3 pack)

Equally important, this craft item is made especially for heavyweight materials such as cardstock, chipboard, mat board, and backed fabric. It ensures that the mat and material are correctly stuck in the whole area without any space between them. It gets more accessible for the [DIYer](#) to remove the extra pieces after the cut. The Strong Grip mat can be found in purple color and is budget-friendly.



5. Card Mat, 2" x 2" (2 ct)

With [Cricut cutting mats](#), increase your card-making speed with this reusable Cricut craft item. The card mat can make four cards simultaneously, covering Insert cards to Cutaway cards. Also, the Card mat is best for last-minute cards and runs with the Cricut Explore & Maker cutting machine. With the help of these craft tools, you can make projects such as greeting cards, birthday cards, anniversary cards, and so on. Like the models, they are also reusable and hold the card perfectly.



Frequently Asked Questions

Question: What Are the Best Ways to Clean Cricut Cutting Mats?

Answer: The methods that will help you in cleaning Cricut mats are as follows:

1. Take the lint roller and roll it all over the mat, and it will stick the dirt and debris on it.
2. You can also use alcohol-free wipes and Awesome spray to remove the dirt.
3. You can also remove the extra pieces using the scraper tool.

Question: How to Remove Extra Adhesive From a Cricut Mat?

Answer: To remove the extra adhesive from the mat, you need to take a clean t-shirt and move it clockwise on the mat surface. The t-shirt will absorb all the extra pieces and will reduce the stickiness back to normal, making it easier to remove unwanted materials in future projects.

Question: How Can I Load a Mat Into My Cricut Machine?

Answer: Read the below steps to learn about loading the **Cricut cut mat** into the craft plotter:

1. Unwrap the Cricut cutting mat and remove the sheet from it.
2. Now, place your material on the mat with the brayer tool.

3. Next, unload the machine cartridge and load it into the machine.
