### On Android

1. Initially, launch the **Play Store** on your Android.
2. Locate the **Cricut Design Space** in the search bar.
3. Then, you'll see a green logo for Cricut Design Space.
4. Thereafter, click on the **Install** option to get the app on your device.
5. When the installation is complete, your app will be added to your **Home** screen.
6. Now, click on the Cricut Design Space icon and launch the application.
7. And then, sign in to your **Cricut account**.
8. Lastly, you're good to go for all the designing and crafting stuff.

## **On iOS**

### **On Android**

1. Initially, make sure that your Cricut product is about 10–15 feet away from your phone.
2. Plug your Cricut to a power supply and turn it on by hitting the **power** button.
3. Launch the **Settings** option on Android and click on the **Bluetooth** option.
4. After turning on the Bluetooth option, your Cricut machine will start detecting the available **Bluetooth** devices.
5. When you see your Cricut machine's name on the screen, click on it.
6. At last, your devices will be paired together.

## **On iOS**

If you're an iOS user like me, you will have to follow different steps. Here are the steps to connect your Cricut to an iPad or iPhone. Let's check them here.

1. Initially, place your Cricut machine in proximity to your iPhone/iPad and turn it on.
2. Now, go to the **Settings** from the home screen on your iOS device.
3. Then, toggle on the **Bluetooth** option on your iOS device.
4. Next, check if your machine appears under the nearby devices.
5. Thereafter, your devices will connect via **Bluetooth** to each other.
6. Lastly, you need to get the [Cricut Design Space](#) on your machine.

## How Can I Connect My Cricut Maker via Bluetooth to Mac?

If you're a Mac user and want to connect your Cricut product to it, follow these steps:

1. Turn on your **Cricut machine** and keep it at a distance of 10–15 feet from your Mac.
2. Now, launch the **System Preferences** option on your screen.
3. Thereafter, select the **Bluetooth** option.
4. Next, allow your Mac computer to search for all the available Cricut machine options.
5. When you see your Cricut machine on the screen, select it.
6. At last, the **Bluetooth** connection process will be completed.

## How Do I Connect My Cricut Maker to a Windows PC?

To connect your [Cricut cutting machine](#) to a Windows PC, follow these steps:

1. Place your Cricut and Windows PC at least 10–15 feet apart from each other.
2. Launch the **Settings** option on the PC.
3. Now, you have to hit the **Devices** option.

4. After that, tap on the **Bluetooth** option.
5. Next, select the **Add Bluetooth or other device** option.
6. Then, hit the **Bluetooth** button to allow your device to scan the machine.
7. In the end, your devices will be paired with each other.
